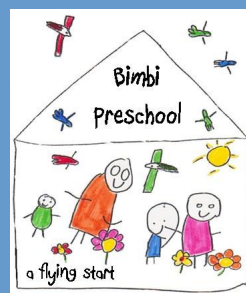

Malcolm Levett Award

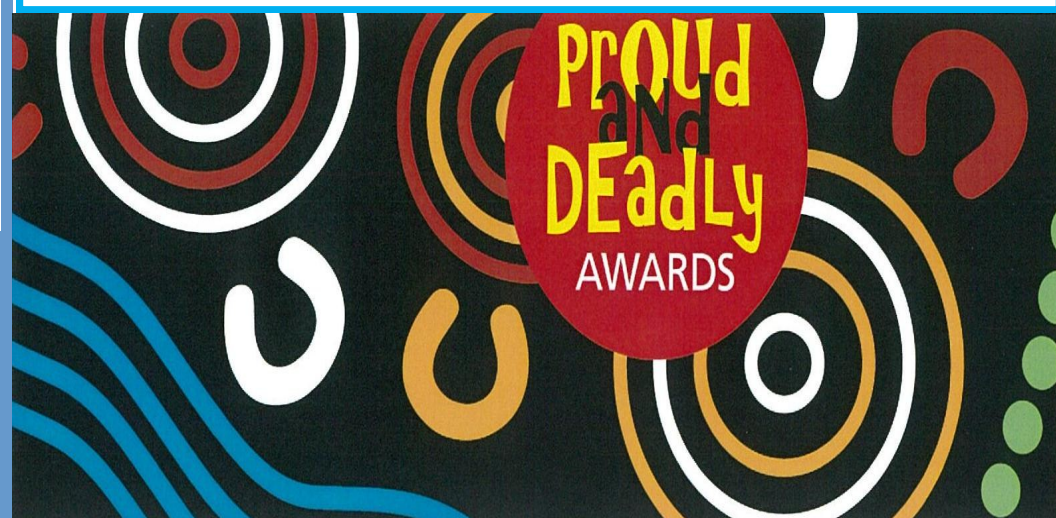
All Yr 6 students are invited to apply for this special award. The award is made in Mr Levett's memory and is dedicated to assisting students to further their education.

Remembrance Day 2013



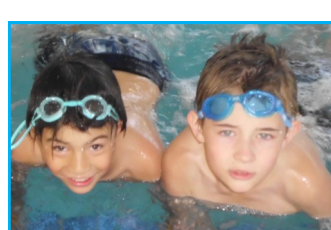
Swim School
