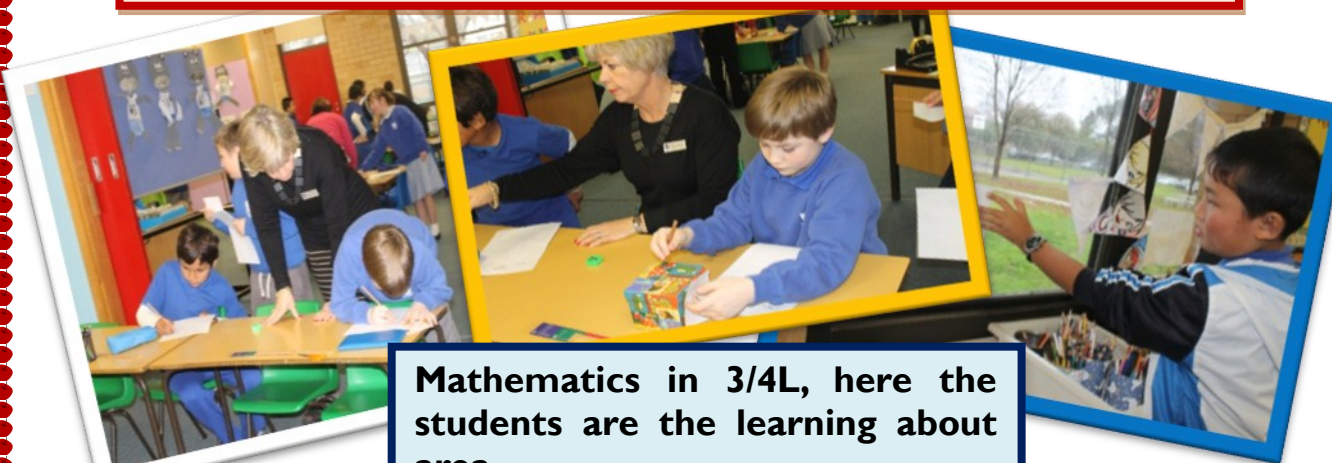

I am a member of the Learning and Support Team of teachers at Tolland Public School.

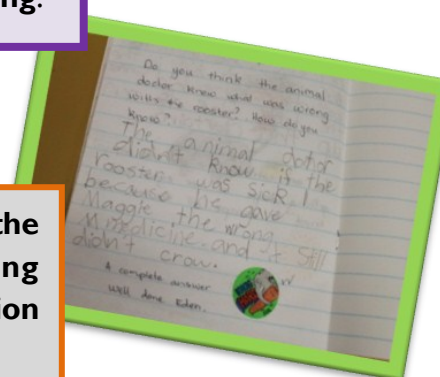
It is my job to assist students to maximise their learning experiences. I work collaboratively with the classroom teachers throughout the school to support specific areas of learning.
