

### Principal's Message

Dear parents,

#### SASS Recognition Week

Next week is School Administrative and Support Staff Recognition Week in NSW public schools. It's a chance to honour the contribution to children that our 16,000 staff who do administrative and support work in school offices, classrooms, libraries, labs, farms and school grounds every day. #### Prescribed Medications

When a medical practitioner has prescribed medication that must be administered during the school day, parents are responsible for:

- ◇ Bringing this need to the attention of the school
- ◇ Ensuring that the information is updated if it changes
- ◇ Supplying the medication and any 'consumables' necessary for its administration in a timely way (eg. epipen, asthma ventilators, specific snacks pertaining to hypos such as jelly beans)
- ◇ Collaborating with the school to work out arrangements for the supply and administration of the prescribed medication.

Parents of children who require prescribed medication to be administered at school must complete a written request. The principal will provide the form to the parent. Students must not carry medications unless there is a written agreement between the school and the student's parents that this is a planned part of the student's health care support. In general, schools do not administer medication which has not been specifically requested by a medical practitioner for an individual student for a specific condition.


We all have a favourite animal that lives on the farm!
