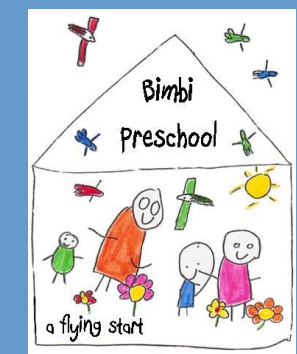


CANTEEN NEWS

HOW2Learn

This term, staff and students are concentrating on speaking 'Learnish' at school. This means we are all trying to think about our learning and talk about the strategies that help us become better learners. In class this term, students have been identifying strategies they can use when they get stuck with their learning. Here is their advice:

- ♦ Think about what you already know (KS)
- ♦ Reread your writing (K/1B)
- ♦ Try all by yourself (1/2EC)
- ♦ Use the 100s chart to help you with your maths (2F)
- ♦ Wait a minute and look again (2-6O)
- ♦ Use the word wall to help you (4/6L)
- ♦ Learning that multiplication and division are related helps work out the answer quickly (3/4L)
- ♦ Check in a book or use the internet (5/6F)
- ♦ Make a connection with something similar (5/6P)
