3/4L News

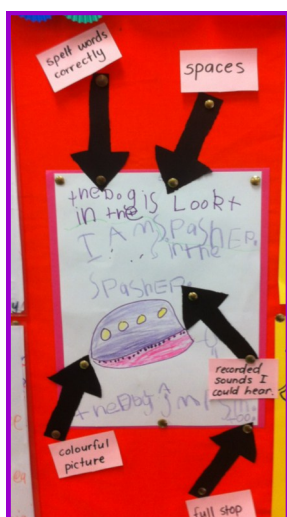
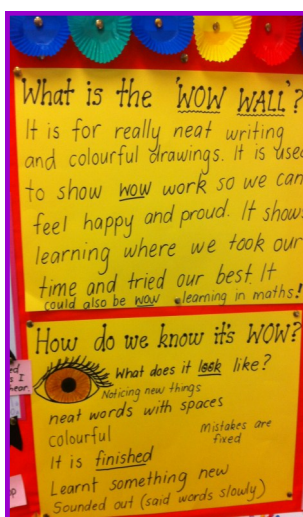

Noticing

Noticing is an essential skill for becoming a better learner. What we notice about our learning is the launching pad for new learning. In our classrooms, students are being encouraged to notice details about their learning and then discuss what they need to learn next. Here is an example of a WOW wall in KS where students display, and then talk about, what they are most proud of with their learning. This process allows students to identify and take ownership of their own learning.
