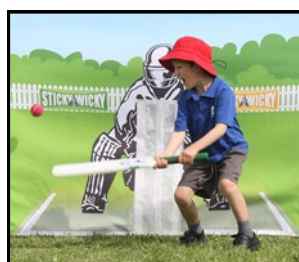
# Class K-1B News
