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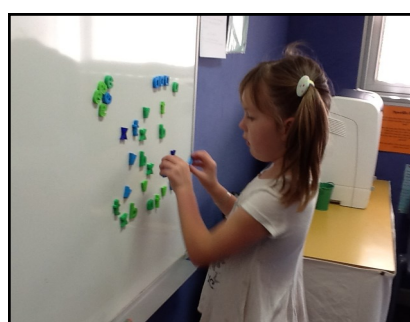
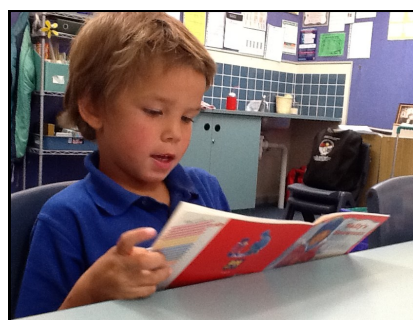

READING RECOVERY & LAST

The Learning and Support Teacher (LaST) provides direct support with adjusted learning programs for students with additional learning and support needs. The LaST teacher plans, implements, monitors and evaluates these programs in conjunction with regular classroom teachers.



Reading Recovery is an early intervention program designed to support students who are struggling with their literacy learning after one year of schooling. The program is aimed to accelerate the child's literacy learning through a specially designed individually tailored lessons delivered daily with a trained Reading Recovery teacher. The teaching involves a focus on comprehending messages in reading and constructing messages in writing with greater independence.

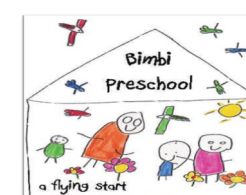
PBL Reward Afternoon
