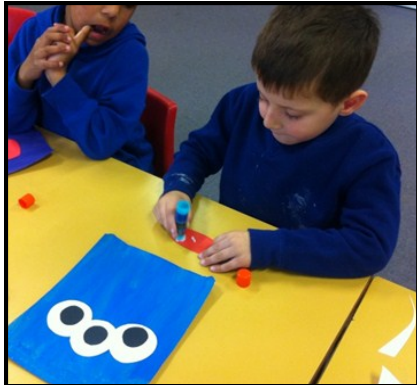
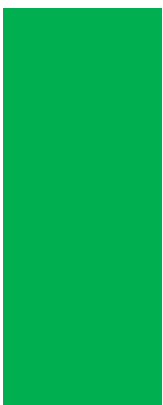
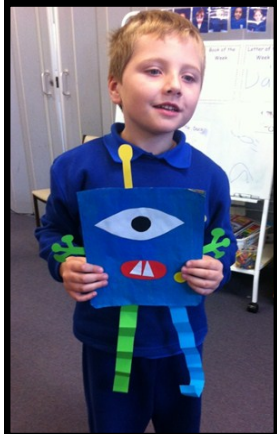
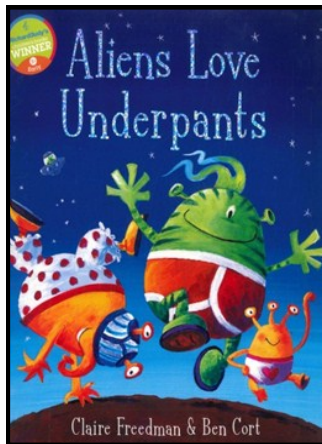


K-1S Class News
