Dear parents,

These last two weeks have a plethora of activities planned for the students. This will culminate with the Dance Concert next Thursday and a reward day for students next Friday. Staff and students will certainly have a well-earned break during the Term 3 holidays.

NAPLAN

Last week students in Years 3 and 5 received their NAPLAN results. Your envelope contained the national *Student Report 2014*, the *Additional Student Reports 2014* and a letter to parents from the Minister for Education. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher. Over the next few weeks staff will spend time analysing school results and will use this data for future planning and targeted intervention for individual students.

Walk with Me

This Friday our students from the unit will be participating in *Walk with Me* which is a walk to show support for people with disabilities and to recognise them as people before their disability. I am sure the weather will be great and the students will enjoy not only the walk but the many other activities provided by the Northcott Society.

Dance Concert

With the end of term next Friday, classes are working hard to perfect their dances and work on their moves. I have had the opportunity to pop into a few practices and also watch dance routines filmed on an ipad. The students are certainly working well with Josh to create a fabulous show. Our Dance Concert finale will be held next Thursday 19th beginning at 12.00pm in the school hall.

Prescribed Medications

When a medical practitioner has prescribed medication that must be administered during the school day, parents are responsible for:

- Bringing this need to the attention of the school
- Ensuring that the information is updated if it changes
- Supplying the medication and any 'consumables' necessary for its administration in a timely way (eg. epipen, asthma ventilators, specific snacks pertaining to hypos such as jelly beans)
- Collaborating with the school in working out arrangements for the supply and administration of the prescribed medication.

Parents of children who require prescribed medication to be administered at school must complete a written request. The school will provide the form to the parent. Students must not carry medications unless there is a written agreement between the school and the student's parents that this is a planned part of the student's health care support. In general, schools do not administer medication which has not been specifically requested by a medical practitioner for an individual student for a specific condition.
