Students will be involved in Wagga PSSA Cross Country on Monday, Mortimer Shield and GRIP Leadership Conference on Tuesday and Wagga PSSA on Thursday. Staff Development Days

Each year it is a requirement that all government schools participate in staff development days throughout the year. These days provide us with the opportunity to make local decisions about the training required for our school staff. This year our school will have the next of the planned professional learning days on Monday July 13<sup>th</sup> (Term 3 Day 1). On this day our school will continue to look at the use of technology in our classrooms, revisit the new curriculum documents and attend a Community of Schools (COS) session on Emotional Intelligence. At the end of the year there are two school development days identified for 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> December - the last 2 days of Term 4. One of these (19<sup>th</sup> December) has been rescheduled for weekend of the 1<sup>st</sup> August. School for students will end as usual on the 17<sup>th</sup> December.

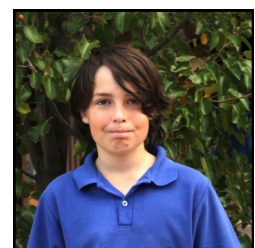

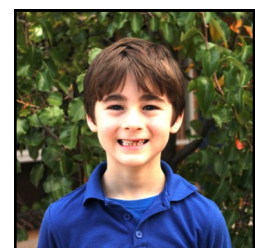
# Kids Speak



**NITBUSTERS**  
**Treatment for Head Lice**

1. Apply a large amount of conditioner to dry hair. This makes combing easier and stuns the lice for about 20 minutes.
2. Comb through with a wide tooth comb.
3. Leave for 3 to 5 minutes.
4. Start at the neck line. Divide a small section of hair.
5. Use a fine tooth comb to remove lice and eggs.
6. Wipe on a tissue or paper towel.
7. Comb every section 4 to 5 times.
8. Repeat steps 5 to 7 with each new section of hair.



**Treat the whole family.**  
**Repeat every 2 days for 1 week to cover the hatching period then check in 1 week.**
