

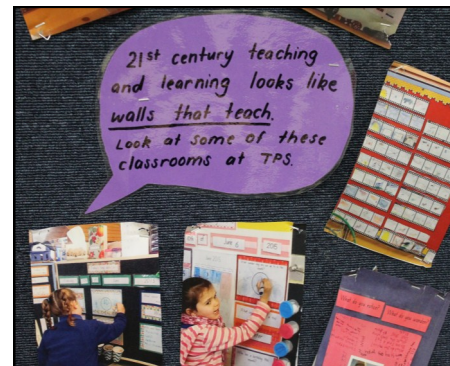


# Teachers Learn Too!

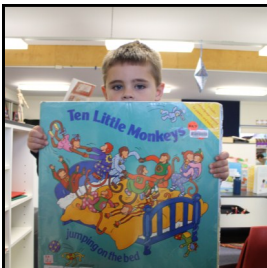

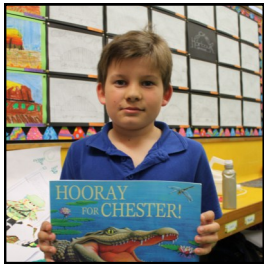

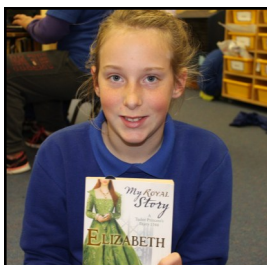

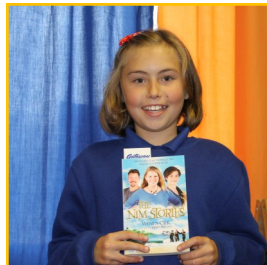
