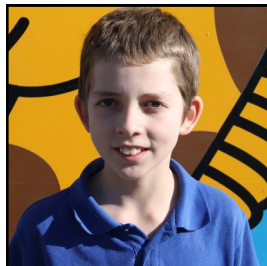

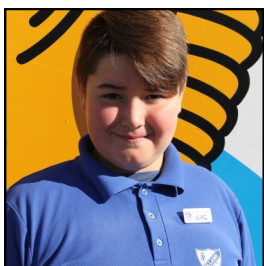

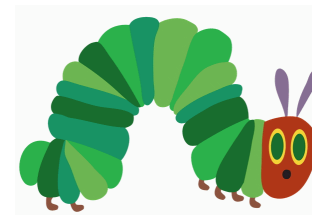

Education Week

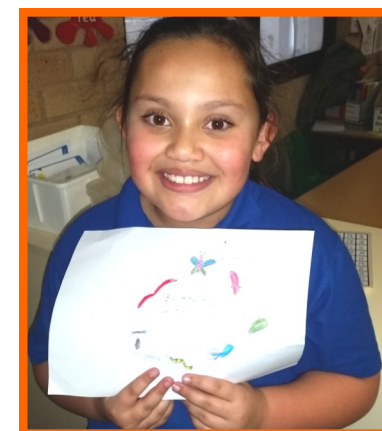
