Dear parents,
This year, the 11th November marks the 98th anniversary of the Armistice (also known as Remembrance Day) which ended the First World War (1914–18). Each year on this day, Australians observe one minute of silence at 11am, in memory of those who died or suffered in all wars and armed conflicts. The red **remembrance poppy** has become a familiar emblem of **Remembrance Day** due to the poem *In Flanders Fields*. These **poppies** bloomed across some of the worst battlefields of Flanders in World War I; their brilliant red colour became a symbol for the blood spilled in the war. Staff and students will observe one minute of silence on Friday at 11am to mark this solemn occasion.



Semester 2 Reports

At the end of this week, teaching staff begin the process of writing Semester 2 reports. The reports reflect on the learning your child has displayed across all areas of the curriculum. One important aspect we report on is student attendance which includes not only days absent but also on students getting to school on time (or partial absences). It is vitally important that students arrive at school on time ready to begin the day. This includes hearing messages and reminders at assembly and also not missing important literacy and numeracy sessions. We ask for your support in this area.

Student Departures

As always, at this time of year we begin to be notified by families who will be relocating to other towns and schools. 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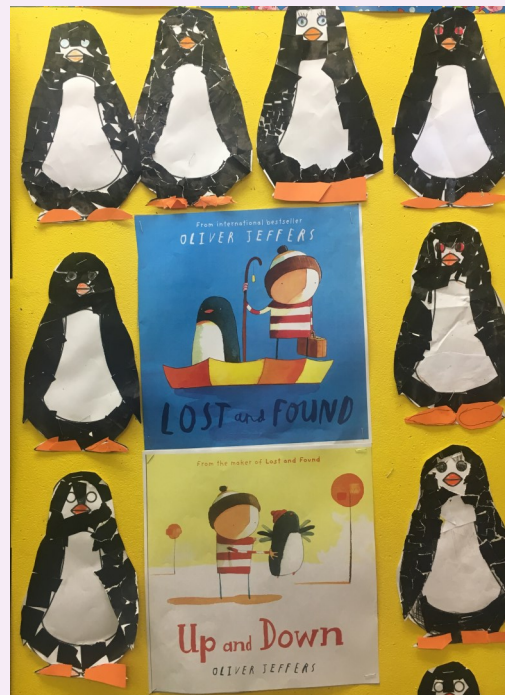
