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
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# BUS SAFETY

On Friday 26th February, Kindergarten students engaged in the NRMA's Bus Safety Lessons. Our Kindergarten classes came together to learn about how we can keep ourselves and others safe when catching buses.

The key messages included:

- We hold an adults hand when we are near the road.
- When waiting for a bus we take 3 big steps back from the side of the road.
- We wait for the doors to open before moving close to the bus.
- If the bus has seatbelts they **MUST** be worn.
- We never eat on a bus, although it is okay to drink water.
- If we ever need help or feel worried, a bus driver is a safe person to ask for help.
