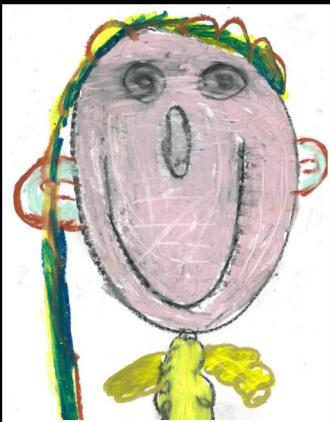

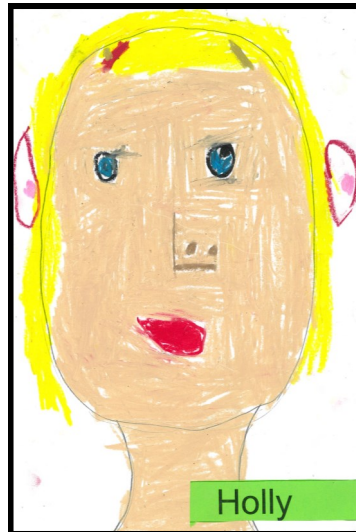
My portrait is of my Mum. I liked using the textas so I could use a lot of different colours.

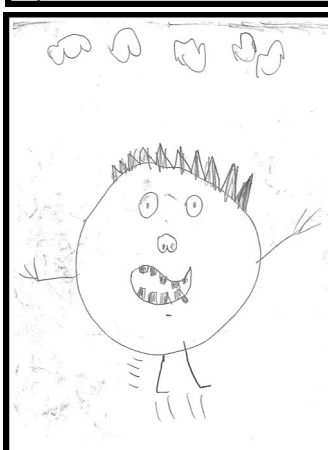
My portrait is of my brother BJ. I liked using the pastels to draw the sharp teeth.
