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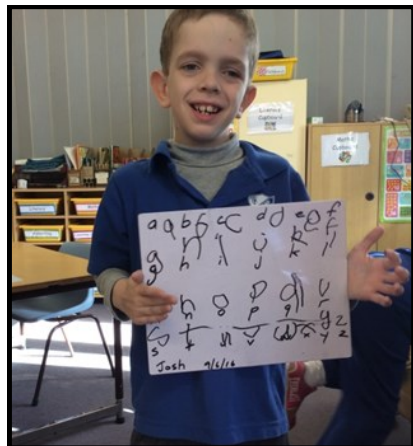

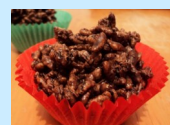
**Year 6 T-shirts** have arrived at the front office. Cost of the T-shirt is \$32.50. Please see the front office if you have not paid.
