School Times

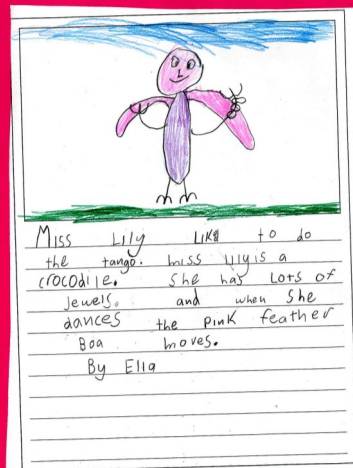

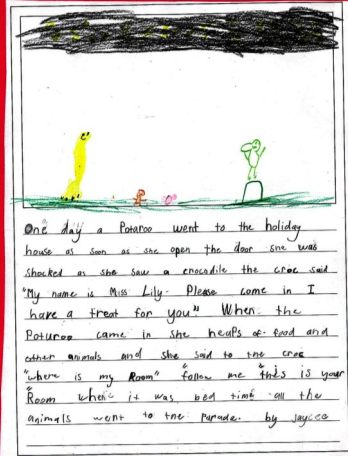

POTOROOS

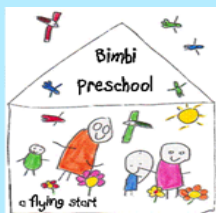

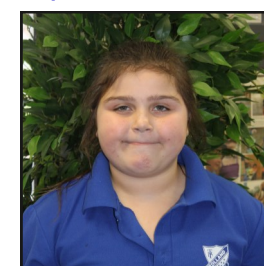
