3-4H Class News

3/4H explore Australia and China

In Geography 3/4H have been investigating the environments of Australia and China to understand why certain animals are native to that place. Every student has chosen their favourite animal that is native to Australia or China to examine further and create a fact sheet. The aim is to prove the importance of the environment to the animal and then they will present their reasons to the class.

We have been practising our research skills using Google docs to help find interesting and factual information on these environments and native animals. Firstly, 3/4H had to identify the type of environment (desert, bushland, ocean etc) that their chosen animal inhabits as this will determine the climate, sources of food and vegetation available.
