Dear families,

This year the 11th of November marks the100th anniversary of the Armistice (also known as Remembrance Day) which ended the First World War. Each year on this day Australians observe one minute's silence at 11am, in memory of those who died or suffered in all wars and armed conflicts. The red remembrance poppy has become a familiar emblem of Remembrance Day. These poppies bloomed across some of the worst battlefields of Flanders in Word War 1; their brilliant colour became a symbol for the blood spilled in the war. Staff and students will observe one minute's silence this Friday at 11am to mark this solemn occasion.
